




Ganga-Farakka Barrage Project and Rural Economy of India

Since Ganga flows from India to Bangladesh, Indo-Bangladesh treaty on Farakka governs flow of Ganga waters to Bangladesh. At the planning stage, likely future negative impact due to obstruction of water flow resulting from Farakka Barrage was overlooked. As a result, extensive sedimentation in the river bed is witnessed today witness obstructs high volume of water during monsoon causing floods in agricultural and residential areas. It also causes water scarcity due to inadequate flow during dry season. Due to hardships caused by both factors, people inhabiting areas close to Ganga are forced to migrate. This book focuses on socio-economic conditions of migrants from Farakka to Malda and Murshidabad Districts of West Bengal and thus the book deals with promise, problems, potential and politics of Farakka Barrage Project.
